

How to make a ringtone from any part of a song on an iPhone (without using a computer)

The song you're using must be available in your purchased music.

Open app "Cute CUT Pro" (or any other video editor that lets you add & edit music from your iTunes).



Create new movie

Add "Music", then choose from "iPod".

Pick the song to use.

Double tap on the song and use scissors to cut out the ringtone (maximum 30 seconds). Trash the sections you do not want by either dragging to the trashcan at bottom (it will appear when you start dragging) or by double tapping and clicking the trashcan.

Export the video.

Open the app "Ringtone Maker". The app is free but has ads.

Choose "Make from video" and select the video you just created.

If the video is longer than 20 seconds then press the "20s" at the top right to increase the maximum length.

Click the check mark at bottom right do you let it know you are done.

Enter file name and select "OK".

After exiting out of another ad, you will see your ringtone. Click on it then choose the share icon. Share it to "Garage Band".

Open the app "Garage Band".



You will see the file you just imported. Long press on the file and choose "Share".

Choose "ringtone", Choose "export".

Choose either "OK" or "Use sound as..."

If you chose "OK" then your new ringtone is available on your phone to either assigned to a contact or assign as your default ringtone.

If you chose "Use sound as..." then you have the option to assign it as your standard Ringtown, your standard text home or assign it to a contact.
(standard = default)
